

TWDC and CBB/BCYB COVID Protocols in compliance with the City of Boston's new vaccine mandate.

There is a new vaccine mandate that covers many businesses in the City of Boston including dance studios that we are responsible for enforcing. Briefly it mandates a vaccine schedule for all unvaccinated participants. The schedule and deadlines are listed below. No unvaccinated adults or children can be allowed to enter the dance studio or lobby based on this schedule. We will be asking all staff and parents to show proof of vaccine for themselves and their children entering the studio based on this schedule as outlined below.

DATE/REQUIREMENT

Saturday, January 15- People age 12+ must show proof of one dose of vaccine

Tuesday, February 15- People age 12+ must show proof of full vaccination

Tuesday, March 1- Children age 5-11 must show proof of one dose of vaccine

Sunday, May 1- People age 5+ must show proof of full vaccination

After January 15 all people over the age of 12 must show proof of one dose of vaccine to enter the studio. Proof could be the actual CDC vaccine card or a photo of the card on a cell phone.

We understand that there is reluctance on the part of some people to vaccinate themselves and/or their children. Unfortunately, this is not optional for anyone if they wish to enter the studio.
